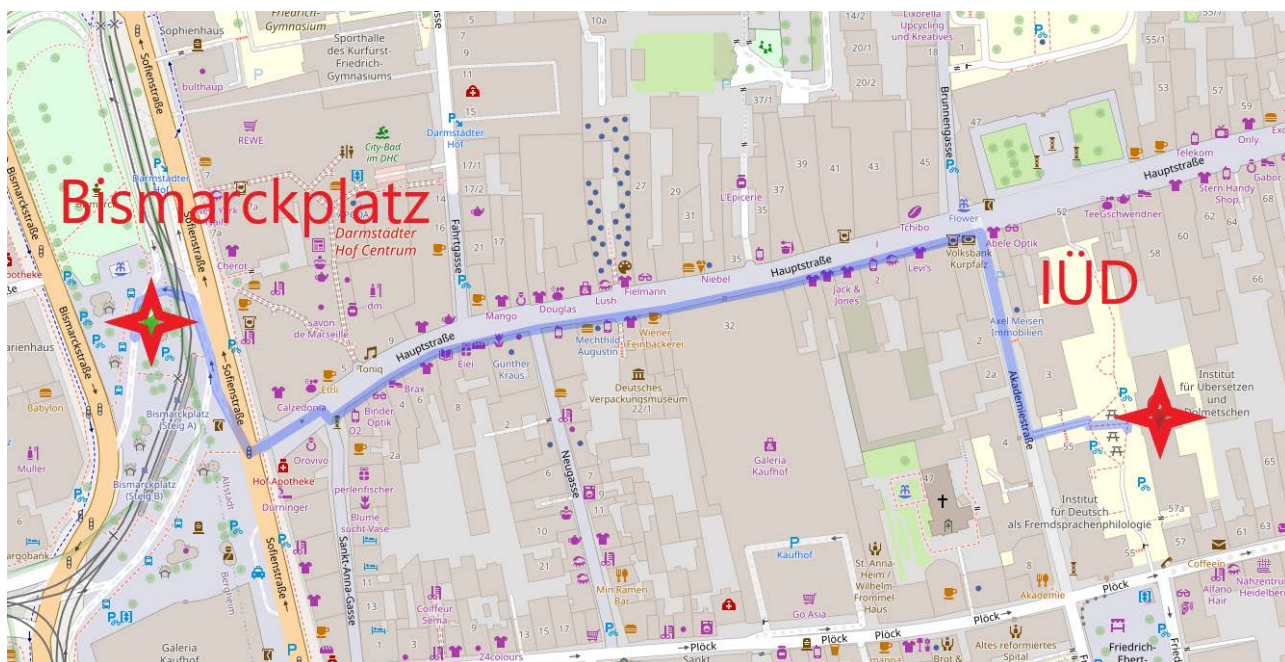
Venue

Transportation

The nearest international airport is Frankfurt am Main. From there, the journey takes about 1 hour by long-distance train (ICE) or 2 hours by regional train. The price for a single journey on a long-distance train is approx. EUR 30 (prices may vary), on regional trains approx. EUR 20. If you use public transport several times, it may be worth buying a [Deutschlandticket](#).

Accommodation

As Heidelberg is a major tourist center, accommodations are available in all price ranges and for all tastes, especially in the central area of the city (Altstadt) where the conference venue is located. However, it is strongly recommended that you book your accommodation as soon as possible, as September sees an influx of both travelers and conference attendees.
